

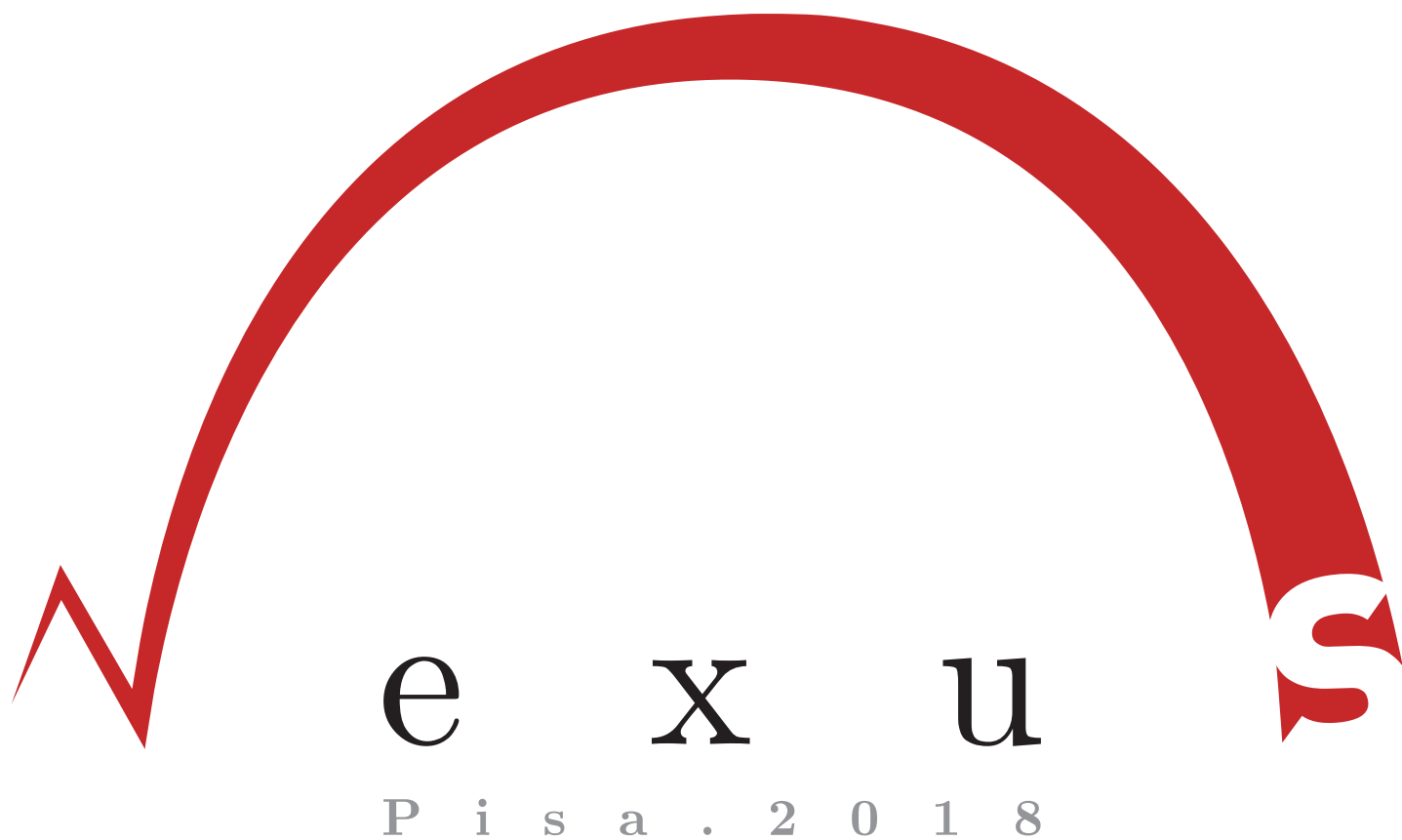
A playful, and yet distinctive shape,
– the arch – dominates this logo.

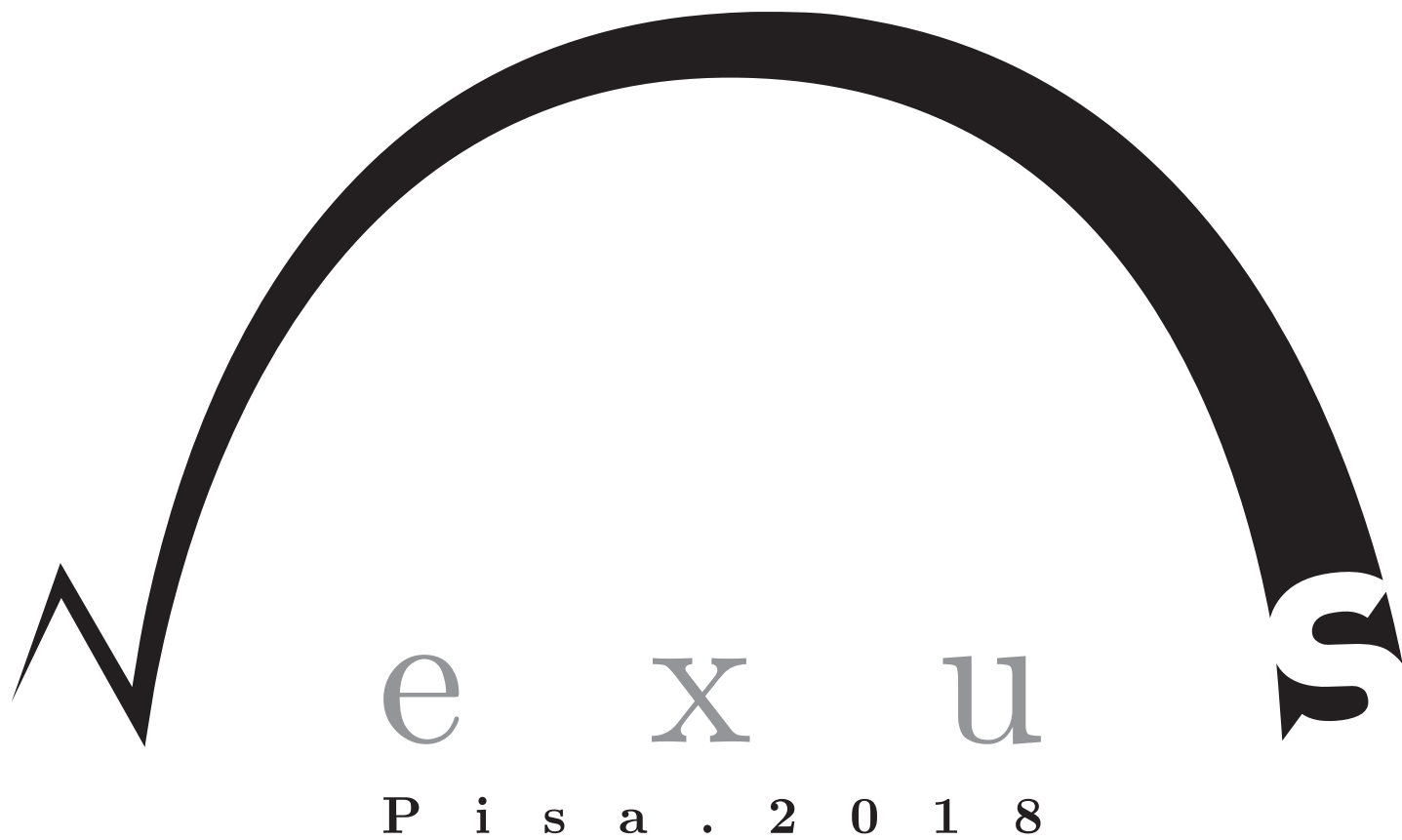
Be it of the roman or gothic kind, the arch [1] is an invariant of the history of architecture. Famous are those of Pisa’s Leaning Tower and Acquedotto Mediceo. As the Oxford Dictionary defines it, a “nexus” is:

“A connection [...] linking two or more things.

The arch connects, in this case, the first and last letters: while the ending ‘s’ is carved out of the tip of the shape as negative space, a seemingly distorted ‘n’ refers instead to the most typical of mathematical symbols: the square root [2].

What else is there to say? The bright red [3] comes directly from the city flag of Pisa (the 2018’s venue), while the typeface [4] must be particularly familiar to mathematicians and researchers who have worked with LaTeX.
